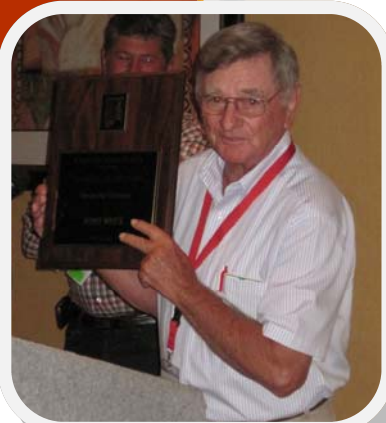

Art Martinez Retires

Long time Senepol breeder, Mr. Art Martinez, owner of Prime Rate Ranch, announced his retirement at the 35th Annual Senepol Convention in Okeechobee, Florida. It is after long consideration that Mr. Martinez, in conjunction with his wife, Maggie decided it was time to downsize their herd and focus their energies on family and their semen and embryo operation.

Fellow Okeechobee resident, and President of SCBA, Mr. Sebastiao De Aguiar of Sacramento Farms, has purchased the Prime Rate Ranch herd and will continue to

breed the bloodline that has been prevalent in the Senepol breed since the Martinez's began with Senepol cattle in 1993.

Mr. Martinez, who is also a part-



ner with Coco Santiago from Ganaderia Santiago will continue to produce embryos through their Nelthropp originated Senepol cows and market semen and embryos. Mr. Martinez made the announcement prior to the elections for Board of Directors, as he was up for re-election this year.

During his announcement at his ranch on Thursday, Mr. Martinez stated that this new direction will allow for him to have more time to devote to the SCBA Board of Directors, of which he has served on the board for many years including President of the association.

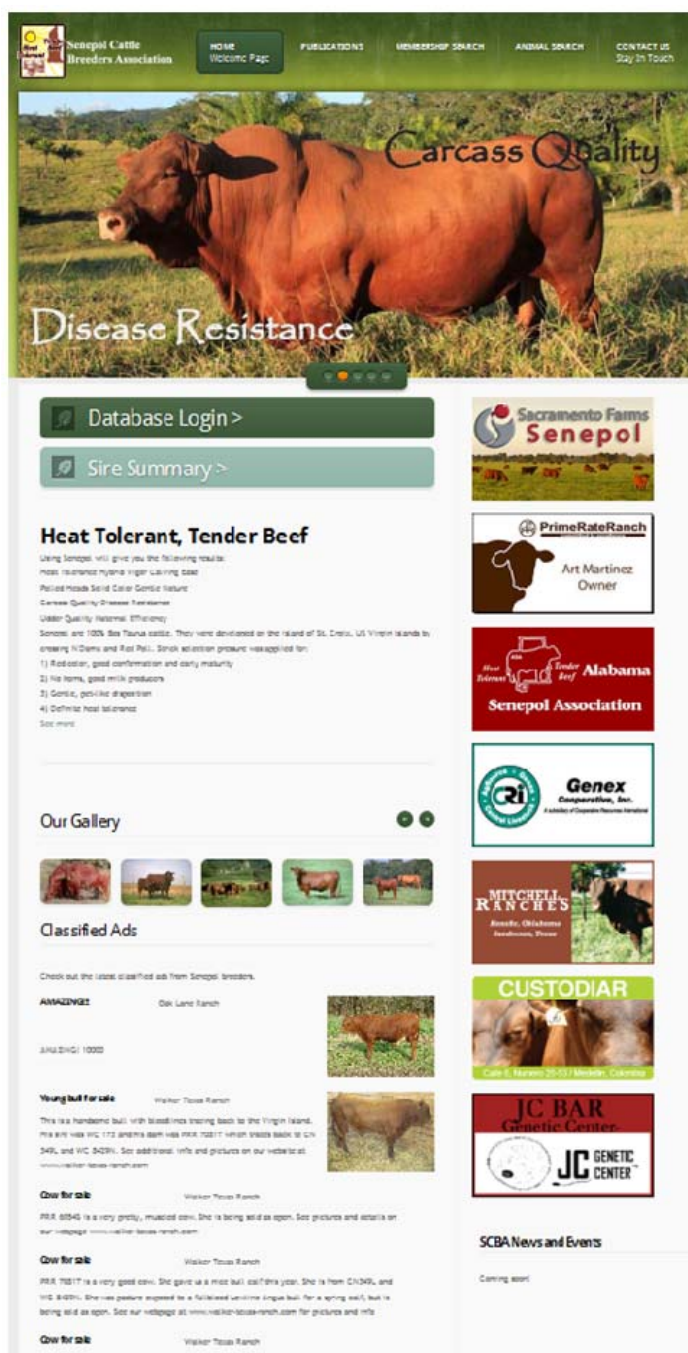
